WHO'S CLIMBING JACOB'S LADDER?

May God pass on to you and your descendants the blessings he promised to Abraham. May you own this land where you are now living as a foreigner, for God gave this land to Abraham." So... Jacob left Beersheba and traveled toward Haran. Genesis 28:4 (NLT)

The Three Acts Of Jacob's Ladder:

Act 1: Heaven Is _____ & _____.

* Jacob left Beersheba and set out for Harran. When he reached a certain place, he stopped for the night because the sun had set. Taking one of the stones there, he put it under his head and lay down to sleep. Genesis 28:10-11 (NIV)

* Awake, O Lord! Why do you sleep? Rouse yourself! Do not desert us forever. Why do you hide your face and forget our misery and oppression? Psalm 44:23-24 (NLT)

Act 2: Heaven Isn't _____ & _____.

* And he dreamed: A stairway was set on the ground with its top reaching heaven, and God's angels were going up and down on it. Yahweh was standing there beside him. Genesis 28:12-13 (CSB)

* Look, I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go. I will bring you back to this land." Genesis 28:15 (NLT)

* Later, Matthew invited Jesus and his disciples to his home as dinner guests, along with many tax collectors and other disreputable sinners. But when the Pharisees saw this, they asked his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with such scum?" When Jesus heard this, he said, "Healthy people don't need a doctor—sick people do." ...I have come to call not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners." Matthew 9:10-13 (NLT)

Act 3: Jacob's _____ Assumption.

* When Jacob awoke from his sleep, he thought, "Surely the Lord is in this place, and I was not aware of it." He was afraid and said, "How awesome is this place! This is none other than the house of God; this is the gate of heaven." Early the next morning Jacob took the stone he had placed under his head and set it up as a pillar and poured oil on top of it. He called that place Bethel. Genesis 28:16-19 (NLT)

* Jesus asked him, "Do you believe this just because I told you I had seen you under the fig tree? You will see greater things than this." Then he said, "I tell you the truth, you will all see heaven open and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man, the one who is the stairway between heaven and earth." John 1:50-51 (NLT)

* "No, we don't know, Lord," Thomas said. "We have no idea where you are going, so how can we know the way?" Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me. John 14:5-6 (NLT)

* **LORD, Forgive my wrongdoing, for it is great. Psalm 25:11 (NLT)**

* That means you must not give sin a vote in the way you conduct your lives. Don't give it the time of day. Don't even run little errands that are connected with that old way of life. Throw yourselves wholeheartedly and full-time... into God's way of doing things. Sin can't tell you how to live. After all, you're not living under that old tyranny any longer. You're living in the freedom of God. Romans 6:12-14 (NLT)

* Then Jacob made this vow: "If God will indeed be with me and protect me on this journey, and if he will provide me with food and clothing, and if I return safely to my father's home, then the Lord will certainly be my God." Genesis 28:20-22 (NLT)

Riverside Info Texting System
