JACOB'S RELATIONSHIP STATUS:

"IT'S COMPLICATED"

As soon as Laban heard that his nephew Jacob had arrived, he ran out to meet him. He embraced and kissed him and brought him home. When Jacob had told him his story, Laban exclaimed, "You really are my own flesh and blood!" Genesis 29:13-14 (NLT)

Jacob & Leah's Tragic Comedy:

Act 1: Scene 3: The _____ Of Jacob's Ladder.

* And he dreamed: A stairway was set on the ground with its top reaching heaven, and God's angels were going up and down on it. Yahweh was standing there beside him.

Genesis 28:12-13 (CSB)

* When Jacob awoke from his sleep, he thought, "Surely the Lord is in this place, and I was not aware of it." He was afraid and said, "How awesome is this place! This is none other than the house of God; this is the gate of heaven." Early the next morning Jacob took the stone he had placed under his head and set it up as a pillar and poured oil on top of it. He called that place Bethel. Genesis 28:16-19 (NLT)

* Jesus asked him, "Do you believe this just because I told you I had seen you under the fig tree? You will see greater things than this." Then he said, "I tell you the truth, you will all see heaven open and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man, the one who is the stairway between heaven and earth." John 1:50-51 (NLT)

* Then Jacob made this vow: "If God will indeed be with me and protect me on this journey, and if he will provide me with food and clothing, and if I return safely to my father's home, then the Lord will certainly be my God." Genesis 28:20-22 (NLT)

Act 2: Scene 1: Jacob Meets _____.

* When Jacob had told him his story, Laban exclaimed, "You really are my own flesh and blood!" Genesis 29:13-14 (NLT)

* After Jacob had stayed with Laban for about a month, Laban said to him, "You shouldn't work for me without pay just because we are relatives. Tell me how much your wages should be." Genesis 29:14-15 (NLT)

* Laban had two daughters. The older daughter was named Leah, and the younger one was Rachel. Leah had weak eyes, but Rachel had a beautiful figure and a lovely

face. Since Jacob was in love with Rachel, he told her father, "I'll work for you for seven years if you'll give me Rachel, your younger daughter, as my wife." Genesis 29:16-18 (NLT)

* Laban said, "It's better that I give her to you than to some other man. Stay here with me." So Jacob served seven years to get Rachel, but they seemed like only a few days to him because of his love for her. Genesis 29:19-20 (NIV)

* But when Jacob woke up in the morning—behold, it was Leah! "What have you done to me?" Jacob raged at Laban. "I worked seven years for Rachel! Why have you tricked me?" Genesis 29:25 (NLT)

* "It's not our custom here to marry off a younger daughter ahead of the firstborn," Laban replied. "But wait until the bridal week is over; then we'll give you Rachel, too—provided you promise to work another seven years for me." So Jacob agreed to work seven more years. Genesis 29:26-27 (NLT)

Act 2: Scene 2: Leah Grasps The _____.

* A week (later), Laban gave him Rachel, too... So Jacob slept with Rachel, too, and he loved her much more than Leah. Genesis 29:28-30 (NLT)

* When the Lord saw that Leah was unloved, he enabled her to have children, but Rachel could not conceive. So Leah became pregnant and gave birth to a son. She named him Reuben (I am seen), for she said, "The Lord has noticed my misery, and now my husband will love me." Genesis 29:31-32 (NLT)

* She soon became pregnant again and gave birth to another son. She named him Simeon (I am heard), for she said, "The Lord heard that I was unloved and has given me another son." Genesis 29:33 (NLT)

* Then she became pregnant a third time and gave birth to another son. He was named Levi (I am loved), for she said, "Surely this time my husband will feel affection for me, since I have given him three sons!" Genesis 29:34 (NLT)

* Once again Leah became pregnant and gave birth to another son. She named him Judah (I will praise), for she said, "Now I will praise the Lord!" And then she stopped having children. Genesis 29:35 (NLT)

* Then I began to weep bitterly because no one was found worthy to open the scroll and read it. But one of the twenty-four elders said to me, "Stop weeping! Look, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the heir to David's throne, has won the victory. He is worthy to open the scroll and its seven seals." Then I saw a Lamb that looked as if it had been slaughtered, but it was now standing between the throne and the four living beings and among the twenty-four elders.
