# The **Big** Story Of The Bible #41 JACOB'S ONGOING RELATIONSHIP STATUS: <u>"It's REALLY COMPLICATED"</u>

So Jacob agreed to work seven more years. A week after Jacob had married Leah, Laban gave him Rachel, too... So Jacob slept with Rachel, and he loved her much more than Leah. He then stayed and worked for Laban seven more years. Genesis 29:28-30 (NLT)

### Jacob & Leah's (& Rachel's) Relationship

1. Leah Senses The

\* When the Lord saw that Leah was unloved, he enabled her to have children, but Rachel could not conceive. So Leah became pregnant and gave birth to a son. She named him Reuben (I am seen), for she said, "The Lord has noticed my misery, and now my husband will love me." Genesis 29:31-32 (NLT)

\* She soon became pregnant again and gave birth to another son. She named him Simeon (I am heard), for she said, "The Lord heard that I was unloved and has given me another son." Genesis 29:33 (NLT)

\* Then she became pregnant a third time and gave birth to another son. He was named Levi (I am loved), for she said, "Surely this time my husband will feel affection for me, since I have given him three sons!" Genesis 29:34 (NLT)

\* Once again Leah became pregnant and gave birth to another son. She named him Judah (I will praise), for she said, "Now I will praise the Lord!" And then she stopped having children. Genesis 29:35 (NLT)

\* There was nothing beautiful or majestic about his appearance, nothing to attract us to him. He was despised and rejected— a man of sorrows, acquainted with deepest grief. We turned our backs on him and looked the other way. He was despised, and we did not care. Isaiah 53:2-3 (NLT)

\* Then I began to weep bitterly because no one was found worthy to open the scroll and read it. But one of the twenty-four elders said to me, "Stop weeping! Look, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the heir to David's throne, has won the victory. He is worthy to open the scroll and its seven seals." Then I saw a Lamb that looked as if it had been slaughtered, but it was now standing between the throne and the four living beings and among the twenty-four elders. Revelation 5:4-6 (NLT)

### 2. The Importance Of \_\_\_\_\_

\* When Rachel saw that she wasn't having any children for Jacob, she became jealous of her sister. She pleaded with Jacob, "Give me children, or I'll die!" Genesis 30:1 (NLT)

\* Then Rachel told him, "Take my maid, Bilhah, and sleep with her. She will bear children for me, and through her I can have a family, too." Genesis 30:3 (NLT)

\* Meanwhile, Leah... took her servant, Zilpah, and gave her to Jacob as a wife. Genesis 30:9 (NLT)

\* But Leah angrily replied, "Wasn't it enough that you stole my husband? Now will you steal my son's mandrakes, too?" Rachel answered, "I will let Jacob sleep with you tonight if you give me some of the mandrakes." Genesis 30:14-15 (NLT)

\* "You must come and sleep with me tonight!" she said. "I have paid for you with some mandrakes that my son found." So that night he slept with Leah. And God answered Leah's prayers. She became pregnant again and gave birth to a fifth son for Jacob. Genesis 30:16-17 (NLT)

\* God has given us this task of reconciling people to him... he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. 2 Corinthians 5:16-19 (NLT)

\* So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples. John 13:34-35 (NLT)

\* Therefore, accept each other just as Christ has accepted you so that God will be given glory. Romans 15:7 (NLT)

\* Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior. Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you. Romans 4:31-32 (NLT)
